Martin Luther loved Nature. He is often associated with the following quote (even if it is not certain, the quote comes from him): "Even if I knew that tomorrow the world would go to pieces, I would still plant my apple tree." And this green thumb legacy lives on in LutherCountry, where the Great Reformer lived and worked. Start with the Luther Garden in Lutherstadt Wittenberg, where 500 trees being planted to mark the 500 anniversary of the Reformation in 2017; then explore the very green and eco-conscious German federal states of Saxony Anhalt and Thuringia, where national parks. elegant gardens and pretty hiking trails welcome visitors from all over the world.

WEIMAR'S CASTLE, PARKS & GARDENS

Martin Luther was a regular visitor to leafy Weimar, a city that swiftly embraced the Reformation. With seven glorious parks, Weimar has always been easy on the eye. The park alongside the River Ilm is home to the Roman House and Goethe's Garden House, where the poet lived and wrote. South of the city Belvedere Palace boasts a romantic park and formal Russian Garden. Tiefurt Palace also has glorious parkland, as does Ettersburg Palace, whose fine example of Thuringian landscape gardening provided the local aristocracy with a cool, calm summer retreat. All these green spaces come under the UNESCO World Heritage Site umbrella.


GARDEN KINGDOM DESSAU-WOERLITZ

In the 18th century, Prince Leopold III of Anhalt-Dessau visited England and was inspired by the new-style of country house landscaping. Today, his legacy is one of Europe's finest landscaping. Loday, his legacy is one of Europe's finest examples of parks and gardens, in half a dozen estates, each with an elegant mansion. In this UNESCO World Heritage Site, covering some 55 square milles, its the palace of Schloss Woerlitz. Halfway between Dessau and Lutherstadt Wittenberg, it looks much as it did 200 years ago, filled with fine art, furniture and porcelain. To enjoy the natural beauty, go for a walk, rent a blike, ride a horse or even take a gondola ride!

With 2017 only a matter of months away, the countdown to the 500th anniversary of the Protestant Reformation is well under way. In LutherCountry, the German federal states of Thuringia and Saxony-Anhait, the anticipation is growing, so come visit now. Stay in the Romantik Hotel at the Wartburg, the hotel next to the castle where he translated the Bible; check in to the Steigenberger Hotel Thuringer Hot, set in the streets where Martin Luther walked, near the house where he lived, and the church where he preached. All are still standing, silent witnesses to the man who changed the course of world history.

EISENACH: THE FORMATIVE YEARS

"No city knows me better," said Luther in later life. After all, while attending the local Latin school, he lived with the Cotta family between 1498 and 1501. That half-timbered medieval house is now the Luther House, a lively museum with a new permanent exhibition about "Luther and the Bible". A choirboy at St. George's Church, Luther later preached his revolutionary ideas here. Remembered at the Bachhaus is Elsenach's most famous son: Johann Sebastian Bach, a passionate Lutheran, as well as a great composer.


WARTBURG CASTLE: TRANSLATING THE WORD OF GOD

Dominating Eisenach is the rugged Wartburg Castle, the "mighty fortress". After his excommunication in 1521, Luther hid here. Astonishingly, in just ten weeks, he translated the whole of the New Testament from Greek to German, using a quill pen. Suddenly, the Bible could be printed by the thousand for anyone to read. To enter the cramped, stone Luther Cell, the room where he worked, is a truly sprintual experience: visitors have been known to drop to their knees here.
